Your Excellency,

I welcome the temporary release of Nobel Peace Prize laureate **Narges Mohammadi** from Evin Prison in Iran, after she was granted a 21-day suspension of her sentence and transferred from prison to home in an ambulance on 4 December.

Mohammadi recently underwent a complicated surgical procedure to remove a bone lesion in her leg suspected of being cancerous. She endured severe pain while battling several other medical conditions during a long period of detention.

This temporary reprieve from prison is an important and necessary first step in her recovery. However, her doctor has recommended a **three-month** furlough for her to receive the comprehensive range of medical care that is required for her to regain her strength and address a number of outstanding health concerns.

I urge the judicial authorities to adhere to the guidance of Iranian medical experts, and to grant Mohammadi access to the full recommended medical treatment and **three months** to recover.
