In accordance with USDA APHIS guidelines, a veterinary import permit is not required for this specimen due to the nature of its origin and expression. Preferably, the specimen should be refrigerated at 4°C.

Name: NK receptor protein

Description: Purified recombinant protein expressed from a human gene in *E. coli* bacteria in the absence of any animal derived products such as fetal calf serum or albumin.

NOTE: *E. coli* bacteria are generally considered non-pathogenic to animals and plants.
