R E Q U I R E M E N T S

ELIGIBILITY

- Non-professional instrumental ensembles of three to six players
- Prepared under the direction of a professional coach
- Any ensemble which devotes a substantial portion of its time performing for a fee is not eligible to compete

AGE LIMIT

The average age of the players in each ensemble must be under 26 as of April 28, 2001

REPERTORY

- A minimum of two complete works of distinctly contrasting character
- From two different musical periods
- Totaling at least 30 minutes of music

CD/CASSETTES

- Serve as the basis for selection of participating ensembles
- The personnel and repertory submitted must be the same at the Competition — No substitutions will be allowed

REGISTRATION FEE

 \$30.00 non-refundable for each member of the ensemble

APPLICATION DEADLINE

- Must be received in the Coleman Office by noon on February 20, 2001
- Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent by March 16

WINNERS CONCERT

- Winners are required to participate
- Sunday, April 29, 2001 at 3:30 p.m.
- Ramo Auditorium on the Caltech campus

 - Do NOT include names of performers or ensemble or any spoken commentary
- Cassettes
 - Submit a separate cassette for each composition
- CD
 - Index by composition and movements

- * Note: Indicate on application your choice of movements for this eight-minute interval. No changes allowed later.

WINNERS CONCERT & AWARDS

- All winners will be presented in public concert on Sunday, April 29, 2001
- Each ensemble will perform all or part of a work from the prepared repertory
- Awards will be presented following the concert
- The Association retains the right to withhold any prize, if, in the opinion of the judges, it is not merited
- The Coleman Chamber Music Association cannot act as agent or manager

RESTRICTIONS OF ELIGIBILITY

- No group may enter the Competition after winning the Coleman-Barstow Award for Strings or the Coleman Award for Woodwinds or Brass
- A member of a group winning the Coleman-Barstow or Coleman Award may compete for the same award only if the remainder of the ensemble consists of entirely new personnel
- Any group which has not won a top award may re-enter the Competition provided a different repertory is submitted
- No individual musician can be a member of more than one ensemble in the Competition
- No member of the ensemble may function as a coach


