WOODWINDS OR BRASS

Available only to woodwind or brass groups, or other
non-string ensembles

REQUIREMENTS

Eligibility

- Non-professional instrumental ensembles of three to six players
- Prepared under the direction of a professional coach
- **Any ensemble which devotes a substantial portion of its time performing for a fee is not eligible to compete.**

Age Limit

- The **average** age of the players in each ensemble must be under 26 as of April 30, 2005.

Repertory

- A minimum of two complete works of distinctly contrasting character
- From two different musical periods
- Totaling at least 30 minutes of music

CD/Cassettes

- CDs and cassettes are the basis for selection of participating ensembles.
- CDs provide the highest quality reproduction and are preferred.
- The personnel and repertory submitted must be the same at the Competition— **No substitutions will be allowed.**

Registration Fee

- \$30.00 non-refundable for each member of the ensemble

Application Deadline

- Must be received in the Coleman Office by noon, **Tuesday, February 22, 2005**
- Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent via e-mail by March 18.

Winners Concert

- Winners are required to participate.
- Sunday, May 1, 2005 at 3:30 p.m.
- Ramo Auditorium on the Caltech campus

Submission of application and sound recordings indicates the ensemble's full intention and financial capability of competing in the 59th Annual Coleman Chamber Ensemble Competition if invited to participate.

INSTRUCTIONS

Please read the instructions very carefully.
All information must be complete.

Application Form

- Fill out **both sides** of the application form.
- **Type or print clearly.**
- List names as they would appear on a program.

Sound Recordings

- Make every effort to submit high quality recordings. **CDs are preferred.**
- Record each composition in its entirety.
- Label recordings and their containers.
 - ▶ Include repertory, timing and Dolby (if used).
 - ▶ **Do NOT include** names of performers or ensemble or any spoken commentary.
- CD
 - ▶ Index by composition and movements
- Cassettes
 - ▶ Submit a **separate cassette** for each composition.

- Your entry must be received in the Coleman Office no later than noon on February 22, 2005. **Late applications will not be accepted.** Do not include publicity materials.
- Must include
 - ▶ Fully completed application form (both sides)
 - ▶ Checks (\$30.00 per performer)
 - ▶ Proof of age (copy of passport, driver's license, etc.)
 - ▶ Social Security or Tax I.D. for each member of each ensemble
 - ▶ CD/Cassettes

Competition Performance

- Each ensemble will perform before the judges for a period of 20 minutes playing portions of their prepared works.
- The first eight minutes will be heard without interruption.*
- Thereafter, the judges will be free to stop the performance at any time and move on to another section.

* *Note: Indicate on application your choice of movements for this eight-minute interval. No changes allowed later.*

Winners Concert and Awards

- All winners will be presented in public concert on Sunday, May 1, 2005.
- Each ensemble will perform all or part of a work from the prepared repertory.
- Awards will be presented following the concert.
- The Association retains the right to withhold any prize, if, in the opinion of the judges, it is not merited.
- The Coleman Chamber Music Association cannot act as agent or manager.

Restrictions of Eligibility

- A member of a group winning the Coleman-Barstow or Coleman-Saunderson Award may compete for the same award only if the remainder of the ensemble consists of entirely new personnel.
- No individual musician can be a member of more than one ensemble in the Competition.
- No member of the ensemble may function as a coach.
- Each member of the ensemble must provide a valid social security number or tax i.d. on the application. Failure to do so will require a withholding of 32% for federal taxes from winner's prizes.
