

Everhart Lecture Series Application/Nomination Form

To nominate a student, complete this form through “Nominator’s Name” and submit it along with a brief, sealed letter of recommendation. The ELS committee will contact the student to obtain a full application.

To apply, submit the following:

1. a completed application form,
2. a list of your publications relevant to your talk (if any),
3. a lecture abstract (no longer than 400 words),
4. a statement regarding why you would be a good ELS lecturer, and
5. two brief, sealed nomination letters commenting on your research and speaking skills
 - a. One written by a faculty member, preferably your advisor
 - b. One written by a fellow student, postdoc, or faculty member

Nomination letters should emphasize the selection criteria described at the Everhart Lecture Series web site, <http://www.its.caltech.edu/~els>. The letters need be no longer than a few paragraphs. The letter should mention how long and in what capacity the author has known the nominee and must be signed and sealed.
