Figure S1: Wholemount of an intracellular fill (cobalt hexamine, Timm's silver intensification) of a bLN of the type examined here. Dorsal is to the top, lateral to the right. Some Kenyon cells were also filled (after the bLN) in this mushroom body. (The calyx, peduncle and lobes together form the mushroom body.)

The bLN was impaled in a dendrite, in the beta lobe. The KCs were impaled in their soma. Only the KC dendrites are visible here. The top half of the roughly spherical antennal lobe is seen at the bottom of the figure. The beta lobe runs at 45 degree along the medial edge of the antennal lobe.
